


FORMAL DINING ROOM

BREAKFAST ROOM

The Breakfast Room was was Mrs. Wrigley's favorite because of the rising sun and spectacular Camelback Mountain views. Adjacent to the Rotunda, it features a dramatic round Swarovski crystal chandelier, chartreuse dining chairs, a custom carpet from Nepal and contemporary artwork by artist Donald Sultan. Four steps. Seats 10 guests.





COLINA ROOM

The Colina Room showcases stunning viewsof the city, a beamed ceiling, fireplace and sitting room. It is perfect for larger gatherings. Formerly Mr. Wrigley's bedroom, it includes a private en suite bathroom with original Catalina tile, and a hallway connecting to the Catalina Room (Mrs. Wrigley's room). It also connects to a spacious gallery that overlooks Geordie's Lounge. Access is from the Grand Staircase or elevator. Seats 40.

CATALINA ROOM

Once Mrs. Wrigley's bedroom, this beautiful room has a hand-knotted Arabella rug and a fireplace surrounded with Catalina tile. Cornices are original, as is the chandelier with amethyst from the Four Peaks mine in Arizona. An adjacent "sleeping porch" offers gorgeous western views. Access via Grand Staircase or elevator. Seats 40 guests.





PASADENA ROOM

Once a guest bedroom, the Pasadena Room features modern crystal chandeliers, an Art Deco fireplace surrounded by Catalina tile, and an en suite bathroom. The chairs are original to the Formal Dining Room and blue walls highlight computer art by late owner Geordie Hormel, and the Poppy series by American artist Donald Sultan. The attached balcony shows off spectacular views. Access to this room is by the Grand Staircase or by elevator. Two steps. Seats 12 guests.

GENEVA ROOM

The Moroccan ceiling and Moravian star pendants echo the painted ceilings in the Rotunda and Living Room. The ochre walls were painted with a four-part decorative strié effect for texture, and guests enjoy an en suite bathroom and access to the balcony overlooking Camelback Mountain. Access from the Grand Staircase or elevator. Two steps. Seats 12 guests.





GARDEN ROOM

Once the family garage and gardens, the Garden Room is now a versatile multi-level event space. It includes a private entrance, bar areas, restrooms and beautiful city and mountain views. The Garden Room has direct access to the Garden Terrace and both have helped create many memories, from weddings to life milestone celebrations, to corporate events. The Garden Room and Garden Terrace can acommodate 250-500 guests.
